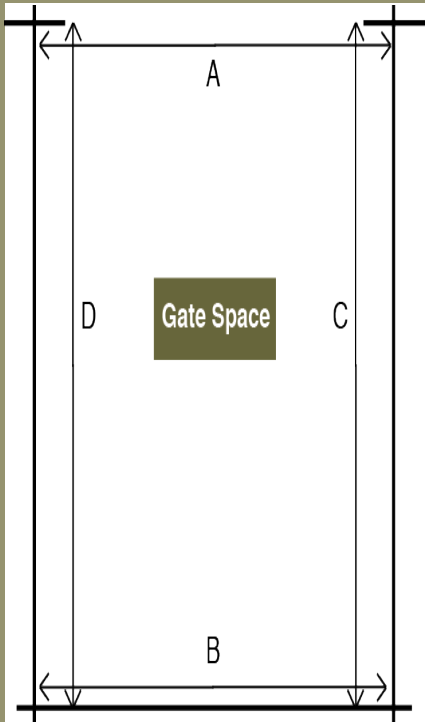


DIY: How to measure your gate...



Measurements (mm)

_____ C Right _____ D Left (H) Height

Gate Frame Calculation

W (smallest) _____ - total width of posts(eg. - 100 mm)

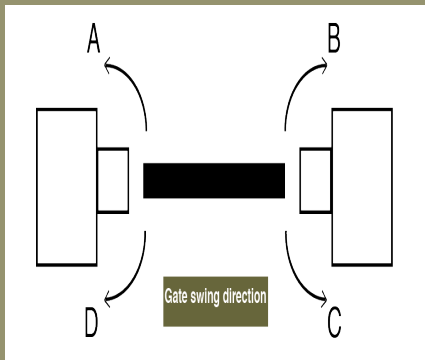
_____ - total width of gaps (eg. - 30 mm) = _____

H (smallest) - total of gaps (eg. -30 mm) = _____

Important Deductions

Remember to take 30 mm from your width measurement for the D&D or Downee Hinges and LockLatch Deluxe or other lockable D latches.

Remember to take 50 mm from your gate height to allow for the rising pathway and/or different heights in the walls



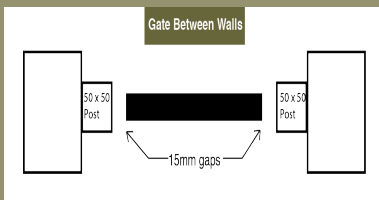
Gate swing direction

Facing the front side of your gate (usually the side that most people can see from the outside of your property), which direction would you like it to swing. Please circle A, B,C or D

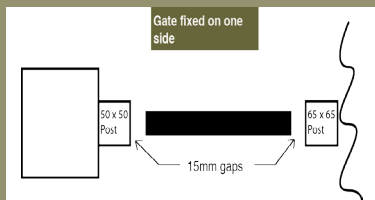

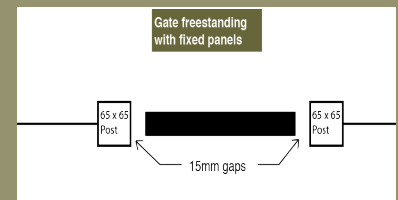
DIY: Dealing with different types of gates



For a gate between walls you will need to allow 2 x 50 mm posts for the gate to swing off and the lock and latch to fit to.



A free standing gate needs a 65/65 post for the gate to hinge to or land on



A free standing gate with panels on either side will need a 65/65 post on each side

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
